Each team is allowed a roster of up to twelve (12) players, and up to Two (2) coaches. The number of games a team plays (Minimum Eight [8] games including playoffs),

Midgets \$300.00 per Team - \$30.00 Referee Fee per game

Juniors \$350.00 per Team - \$40.00 Referee Fee per game

Seniors \$375.00 per Team - \$45.00 Referee Fee per game

Player eligibility

- **Future Star** - Players will be considered ineligible if he reaches his 9th birthday before the first scheduled game.
- **Biddy** - Players will be considered ineligible if he reaches his 12th birthday before the first scheduled game.
- **Midgets** - Players will be considered ineligible if he reaches his 14th birthday before the first scheduled game.
- **Juniors** - Players will be considered ineligible if he reaches his 16th birthday before the first scheduled game.
- **Seniors** - Players will be considered ineligible if he reaches his 18th birthday before the first scheduled game.
- **Player's age** will be confirmed by recent school or state issued ID with legible date of birth on ID / Birth Certificate.
- **Any team found to be using ineligible players will forfeit all games in which said player participates, and is also subject to ejection from the tournament.**

Rosters

- Each team is allowed up to twelve (12) players and two (2) coaches on their official roster.
- Rosters will be frozen at the start of the *Second* game.

Game Day Conduct

- **Teams must wear Team Uniforms (Tops & Bottoms).**
- Teams must be ready to play at scheduled game time. The Forfeit clock will begin at starting time. For every 5 minute after forfeit clock starts the opposing team will be awarded 5 points. 20 minutes after game Start time, game will be declared a forfeit.
- **48 HOUR NOTICE IS MANADORY FOR SCHEDULE CHANGE.**
- Players are expected to treat their teammates, coaches, opponents, officials and Gladiator Staff with respect. No foul language is permitted.
- Players are expected to greet (slap or shake hands) opposing players at the beginning and end of each game. Poor Sportsmanship will not be tolerated.
- Only players and coaches are allowed to sit on the bench during the game.

Rules

- All games will be four (4) quarters. Each quarter will run
- (7) minutes Running Time – Future / Biddy
- (8) minutes Running Time – (Midgets, Juniors and Seniors)
- Time clock will run until the last minute (1:00) of 2nd and 4th quarters.
- The clock will stop on timeouts, injuries, and referee's discretion.
- Each team will receive Five (5) timeouts per game. Three full timeouts and Two thirty (30) second timeouts.
- In the event of a tie at the end of regulation, there will be an additional (2) minute overtime period. Time stops on dead balls during final minute of each overtime period. In event of a third overtime period, SUDDEN DEATH RULE applies. The 1st team to score 2 points (FG, 2 Free Throw) wins the contest.
